Flo Crowe & The Dilemmas Shy Girl



RELEASED: October 31st, 2025

Exciting new Cornish outfit, *Flo Crowe & The Dilemmas* signed to Little Genius Recordings in early 2025.

Shy Girl will be the band's second single for the label, and like its predecessor, the acclaimed debut single *That Was That* the track is taken from their upcoming eponymously titled full length album.

For those who are yet to be introduced, *Flo Crowe & The Dilemmas* are a voice focused five-piece who deal in folk-tinged layered harmonies over electro pop beats with a smattering of gritty guitar motifs. At an average age of just 19, they are Flo Crowe (lead vocals and keys), Cerys Wilcox (soprano vocals), Paige Mullin (alto vocals) Grace C.G. (guitar and backing vocals) and Moses Seaber (E drums).

In what has so far been a year of highlights, the band have debuted on **BBC Introducing**, racked up a small mountain of glowing reviews and made their second major festival appearance - they joined an illustrious line-up that included Raye, The Prodigy, Central Cee and Wet Leg at **Boardmasters 2025**. Music press fans include **Louder Than War** who described their

sound as ‘bittersweet and enchanting’ and Flo’s vocals as ‘sublimely expressive’. Ireland’s Q Radio, perhaps keen to underline the Celtic connections between Cornwall and the Emerald Isle have been very supportive. Olga Kaye, the station’s Alternative Music host described Flo Crowe & The Dilemmas’ sound as simply gorgeous.

An impressive start then, and one the band are hoping to build on...

“Earlier this year I said that I was hopeful that our music, and the motivation behind what we do would connect way beyond our native Cornwall – that we wanted to invite everyone, wherever they are, to join our clan. Some of that is now beginning to happen – the support we are picking up is exciting, and I’m confident that Shy Girl will help us accelerate that journey.

Part of the idea behind ‘Shy Girl’ is to kick back against the expectation of women needing to be ‘seen and not heard’ and demure – that tradwife thing we are hearing about in some areas of social media. The so-called ‘Shy Girl’ is polite and won’t make a fuss. Well! We think, along with many other women, that we have the right to make a fuss. This idea is brought to life in the very first lyric line... ‘Outta my way’ immediately crushes any false impression you may get from the song title.”

Shy Girl will now be released by Little Genius Recordings on October 31st, 2025. It’s available anywhere you can buy or stream music.
